The global crisis sparked by the COVID-19 pandemic has been unprecedented in its scope and impact. It hit harder those in vulnerable situations, including women and children.

Women make up over 70% of the global health workforce and are more likely to be front line workers. The pandemic is also deepening pre-existing inequalities as well as increasing exponentially economic inequalities, gender-based violence and unpaid care work.

Although children are not the face of this pandemic from the health point of view, they risk being the biggest victims. An estimated one in six children - or 356 million globally - were living in extreme poverty before the pandemic began, and this is set to worsen significantly.

Women and children have long been a priority for the United Nations. Together with our partners, we have made historic progress in improving the health and well-being of women and children around the world. However, the ongoing COVID-19 crisis threatens to reverse years of progress. In this Decade of Action to deliver the Sustainable Development Goals, we need to ensure

that women and children remain at the heart of COVID-19 recovery efforts.

As Honorary President of the United Nations Women's Guild (UNWG) and a committed International Gender Champion, I firmly believe that it is only through creating equal opportunities that we can achieve our common goals. The UNWG is making a tangible contribution to the work of the United Nations, with an impressive 2,000 projects in over 100 countries for the benefit of disadvantaged women and children. I would like to warmly thank all the members of the UNWG for their exceptional dedication to this admirable cause.

This year's Bazaar theme "Equal rights, equal opportunities and equal responsibilities for all" provides us with a welcome opportunity to recommit to these shared goals. The Bazaar is an inspiring example of the value of individual engagement, where the talents and skills of all cultures can contribute to a shared objective.

The support of vulnerable children and women who live in difficult conditions in various parts of the world is a central commitment of the United Nations Women's Guild (UNWG). It does this by financing microprojects and by offering multi-year scholarships.

The Covid pandemic has caused considerable disruption to our ongoing efforts to raise funds. Notwithstanding this, charities like ours have proved, time and again, their resilience by adapting and innovating in different ways.

The UNWG persisted in its efforts and offered its members and wider community new fundraising initiatives with which we were able to continue to support some of the most vulnerable. In this respect, we are extremely pleased that the UNWG succeeded in supporting underprivileged children, their mothers and their wider communities in 12 countries around the globe by supporting micro projects focusing on providing for basic needs, health, safety and education. Financing these projects was possible through the combined fundraising efforts of UNWG members, the wider philanthropic community and generous donations from the UNWG partners.

The UNWG International Bazaar is by far the most significant expression of multi donor collaboration and we are extremely grateful that after a one year hiatus we are able to hold this international event which will provide us with much needed funds to continue supporting children and women in need. We wish to thank very warmly the United Nations office in Geneva, the Permanent Missions involved in the Bazaar and many donors who contributed to the success of this event.

UNWG also accompanies children in their education by providing multi-year scholarships for the secondary school students. Funds are raised through the Children's Walk activity involving school children and their dedicated teachers from international schools from cantons of Geneva and Vaud. Currently the UNWG is supporting four multi-year scholarship programs where over 70 students are provided with funds towards school fees, school uniforms, textbooks and food. In addition to raising funds, the Children's Walk also seeks to increase awareness and to promote the culture of solidarity among children living in Switzerland to the plight of other children around the world who may not enjoy the same educational opportunities and face other challenges such as access to clean water and sanitation.

I invite you to enjoy the International Bazaar and join us in this worthy cause by making your contribution. We should never forget that "children are one third of our population and all of our future."

Projects 2020 – 2021

Benin

CRAPID-ONG est une organisation d'œuvres sociales et de développement centrée sur les initiatives locales et communautaires. Elle accompagne les communautés défavorisées dans la satisfaction de leurs besoins essentiels, comme l'eau potable et scolarisation des enfants. Les fonds ont été utilisés pour fournir de l'eau potable à la communauté de Karo afin de réduire la prévalence des maladies hydriques dans la population, en particulier chez les enfants et les jeunes mères.



Action Benin et Solidarité est une association béninoise à but non lucratif d'éducation populaire et de solidarité nationale. Elle ouvre pour une amélioration des conditions de vie et de travail des populations vulnérables, surtout les femmes, les artisans et les enfants déscolarisés. Les fonds ont été utilisés pour offrir une formation professionnelle aux filles qui se trouvent dans des situations difficiles et qui ne sont pas scolarisées, dans la domaine de la couture avec un accent particulier sur la santé reproductive, le SIDA et la pandémie de COVID.

Colombia

Casa Infantil Estrella De Oriente is a day care centre for children (aged 6 months to 5 years) from extremely poor backgrounds whose parents can't afford to pay for their day care and who cannot take care of them since they have to work as domestic workers or street vendors. The UNWG funded the purchase of inox tables to replace old wooden tables. The old furniture was in very bad state and the authorities indicated they would have to close down the day care centre if the tables wouldn't have been replaced.



DRC Congo

L'Institut Supérieur en Sciences infirmières (ISSI) est un établissement privé d'enseignement supérieur situé dans la commune de Mont-Ngafula à Kinshasa en RD Congo. Il a pour mission de former des infirmiers de qualité qui fournissent à la population des soins de qualité; de contribuer à la formation continue du personnel de santé, en particulier de ceux qui travaillent dans le domaine de la santé maternelle et infantile; de contribuer au développement de la profession infirmière et à la revalorisation sociale de l'infirmière en RDC. Les fonds ont été utilisés pour contribuer à la lutte contre la Covid-19 en milieu scolaire dans la commune de Mont-Ngafula et à améliorer des pratiques et conditions d'hygiène dans différentes écoles de Mont-Ngafula.

Ecuador

Fundacion a Mano Manaba is a non-profit organisation empowering girls and women through formal and informal educational programmes which strive to eradicate violence and to promote gender equality, so that this group of strong women and girls can spearhead social development in the northern coast of Ecuador. The funds were used to purchase materials and books and to partially finance training for trainers for young adults) in educational programs striving to eradicate violence, decrease teenage pregnancy, promote gender equality, female leadership and environmental awareness. The project will have a spill over effect and will be implemented later on in other local communities on the northern coast of Ecuador. All materials will be used in the community library.

India

Darjeeling Children's Trust is registered charity organisation since 2011 and focuses on the advancement of the education, well-being, living conditions and health of children in Darjeeling. The funds were used to build underground water harvesting for children's home to provide them with appropriate water supply throughout the year which will have a direct impact on their health and well-being.



Indonesia

Yayasan Abdi Pertiwi Bogor is an independent foundation that offers free education for children from impoverished backgrounds whose parents can't afford to pay for their schooling. The funds provided by the UNWG were used to purchase multimedia equipment to introduce Science and Technology to students in order to improve quality of learning in accordance with the demands of time.

Madagascar

Association des Amis des Familles et Ecoles a Madagascar accompanies disadvantaged families to give children a chance to access to schools and supports them to continue schooling. The association also takes care of medical expenses for families that cannot afford to pay for them. The funds were used towards covering expenses for medical and dental check ups of children and to provide nutritious food for school breakfasts.

Mauritius

Shelter for Women and Children in Distress Trust Fund is a grassroot, non-profit organisation for battered women and abandoned children. Organisation provides safe and nurturing environment where women and children can obtain support and services they need in order to achieve self-sufficiency. Funds from the UNWG were used to purchase electrical appliances for the shelter to better store the food, to ensure cleanliness and to provide better services to the inhabitants of the shelter.

Morocco

Association Espoir Trait d'Union est une association à but non lucratif. Elle vise à promouvoir la culture de la réconciliation, cohésion sociale et paix. Elle collabore avec NGOs et les autorités compétentes pour participer à la réalisation des objectifs du développement durable. Les fonds du CFNU ont été utilisés pour entreprendre des opérations de forage de puits dans des zones rurales éloignées des agglomérations urbaines, afin que les jeunes mères et/ou les enfants puissent se concentrer sur la prise en charge de la famille et de la scolarité et ne soient pas utilisés pour chercher de l'eau.

TIMIDI Association for Development and Cooperation is a non-profit organisation in rural area of Tamslghat focusing on improving situation of children, women and people with disabilities by contributing to the economic, social and cultural development of the inhabitants. The funds from the UNWG were used to purchase sewing machines and materials to teach young women embroidery and sewing and to help them earn money for themselves.



Pakistan

World One Country Association is a non-profit organisation focusing on creating Montessori education centres for young children and creating opportunities for young women and mothers to learn new vocational skills - sewing. The funds from the UNWG were used to finance training for teachers in Montessori teaching methods, who in turn will teach children between 3 and 6 years in Montessori techniques.

Sierra Leone

Education pour Tous is non-profit organisation aiming at improving the education opportunities for children and young women in isolated communities of Sierra Leone as well as improving the quality of teaching in those communities. The funds were used to organise training courses in literacy, basic hygiene and family planning.

Uganda

CALI Foundation is an NGO focusing primarily on empowering vulnerable women and girls by offering diverse educational programs aimed at preparing them to live to their full potential. The foundation empowers women with vocational skills such as tailoring, catering, economic empowering programmes, etc. Funds from UNWG were used to purchase materials to improve the nutritional diet and overall health of students (mostly adolescent girls) and teach them cooking and farming skills by creating a school garden to grow various vegetables, herbs and fruits.


