



MESSAGE FROM THE VICE-PRESIDENT PROJECTS



In 2024, the UNWG Geneva has been fortunate enough to support 23 separate projects. These all aim to help children and women around the world, with a focus on education, physical health, mental health, sanitation, and building the future. The funds raised at the International Bazaar allow us to finance numerous specific, targeted projects each year, especially for those people in vulnerable circumstances. Funds were allocated to projects in Benin, Bulgaria, Cameroun, Côte d'Ivoire, Colombia, Croatia, DR Congo, Egypt, India, Kenya, Moldova, Morocco, Peru, South Africa, Sierra Leone, Sri Lanka, Ukraine, Kenya, Dominican Republic, Uzbekistan, and Zimbabwe. Specific information about each of these can be found in this brochure.

The UNWG also provides scholarships that allow secondary school students to finish their education. Through their schools, students in difficult situations are provided money to help cover school fees, uniforms, textbooks and transportation. Funds are generated primarily through the Children's Walk, which involves primary school children and their dedicated teachers from international schools in and around Geneva.

We are hopeful that, with the funds raised in last two years, we will be able to open two more scholarships this year.

In addition to raising funds, the Children's Walk fosters awareness among schoolchildren living in Switzerland. These children learn about the struggles of people who may not enjoy the same educational opportunities that they do, and who face barriers to studying, such as access to books, clothes, clean water and sanitation.

Thank you for allowing the UNWG to support these life-changing projects.

Projects Supported by UNWG Geneva in 2024

Bulgaria, Sofia : "It's up to us" foundation

The foundation "It's up to us", created on 23 Feb 2023, strives to inspire and mobilize people to undertake work with positive social impact. Set up to help 500 Ukrainian refugees with food, hygiene, clothes, toys and then help them to integrate. It has now expanded to include vulnerable groups of Bulgarians. The UNWG support provides help to around 60 people, with a toy and book library, weekly drop-in classes (book reading, baby music, arts and crafts), support sessions for mothers, volunteer training program (lead age-appropriate activities, cultural sensitivity training, and community outreach). We have also provided furniture and educational and developmental equipment.

Cameroun, Yaoundé : Groupe scolaire bilingue privé laïc Tiama

Ce projet sert 318 enfants de 3 à 11 ans d'un groupe scolaire bilingue privé laïc Tiama (maternelle et primaire). Le but est d'améliorer les conditions de l'école Tiama pour une meilleure éducation des enfants. Il s'agit principalement d'une installation d'un deuxième réservoir d'eau (car le nombre d'élèves a augmenté), et de fabriquer et fournir 60 lits pour les enfants de la maternelle.

Côte d'Ivoire, Abidjan : Association pour le Développement Social et Culturel (ADESC)

Ce projet vise directement 30 filles, élèves de la 6ème à la terminale, entre 11 et 19 ans, mais touchera aussi 240 bénéficiaires indirectes. Des secteurs d'activité comprennent l'éducation extra-scolaire, actions sociales, santé primaire, formation professionnelle. Le « Teen academy » renforcement des capacités des filles du quartier de Yopougan dans une perspective de genre:

1. Renforcement des capacités de travail des élèves (méthodes de travail, mémoire)
2. Formation et suivi spécialisés en développement personnel des jeunes filles pour qu'elles croient en leurs capacités de poursuivre leur formation et de réussir. Le projet fournit aussi des livres, ordinateur, et une TV pour des formations en présentiel et en ligne, une table de travail en groupe, 4 tables, 12 chaises, 5 ventilateurs, 1 armoire, et 2 bâches pour cours en extérieur.

Projects Supported by UNWG Geneva in 2024

Colombia, Cali : Fundacion Los Valles

The Fundación los Valles touches 200 children and adolescents and their families, with a potential reach of 750-800 beneficiaries. It provides crucial soft skills and leisure time for children, allowing them to make the most of free time through artistic expression. The Creder Creando - Proyecto Ludoteca encourages children and adolescents to read; it implements recreational workshops to promote cognitive, psychomotor and socio-affective development; it encourages the practice of basic human values for coexistence and individual and collective development. In addition, the UNWG has purchased materials, furniture and toys for the toy library in order to provide a comfortable space for children and adolescents to play in.

Croatia, Gornje Selo, Island of Solta Udruga Osemijeh. Association for social integration of all age groups on the island of Solta

The Udruga Osemijeh association for social integration of all age groups on the island of Solta has been provided supported with equipment for the therapy of children with developmental difficulties. This includes essential didactic equipment for the work of sensory integration therapists, speech therapists, and psychologists.

DR Congo : Les Enfants de Panzi et d'ailleurs

Au minimum 100 enfants sont soutenus par Les Enfants de Panzi et d'ailleurs. Le centre de ce soutien est une bibliothèque et ludothèque communautaires pour des enfants qui sont des victimes (ou nés de la) violence et l'abus sexuel.

Egypt, Giza : Esmaaona Foundation

In this straightforward project, “Incubators save souls”, the Esmaaona Foundation provides incubators for 12-20 newborns per month.

Projects Supported by UNWG Geneva in 2024

India, Howrah : Don Bosco Ashalayam

Don Bosco Ashalayam implements a project of training and education for all. In addition to basic education, it provides technical and professional training workshops for beauticians, sewing, bike repair, renovation of installations, and sport education.

India, Maharashtra : Mata Balak Utkarsha Pratishthan, Sangola

From grades V to XII, approximately 600 students will benefit from the Computer laboratory. Mata Balak Utkarsha Pratishthan, Sangola focuses on empowering rural families, with a focus on health, fighting injustice, skills development, financial independence, and environmental awareness. The computer education for rural children intends to introduce, familiarize and help master IT tools and technology by young, bright and enthusiastic rural children to help them keep pace with the fast-changing world. The UNWG has purchased 10 computers for the computer lab, 2 laptops for teacher use and a printer.

Moldova, Chisinau : The Moldova project association

This association reaches over 1000 children living in rural areas and from vulnerable families. It protects the rights and interests of at-risk and refugee children through partnerships with local authorities, involvement of the civil society and the family members. The village playroom - a chance to learn for little hearts - are safe and friendly spaces opened by the Moldova Project in collaboration with local authorities in disadvantaged communities. They are located in schools and other public institutions and are used by children for self-improvement, socialisation and after-school relaxation. The activities are co-ordinated by a playroom supervisor. The UNWG has contributed board games, books and scanner / printers for 5 playrooms.

Morocco, Casablanca (near Marrakech) : Décideurs du succès pour la formation et le développement (Success Makers Casablanca)

"Décideurs du succès pour la formation et le développement (Success Makers Casablanca)" encadre et guide jusqu'à 500 élèves. Ils luttent contre l'abandon scolaire des filles; stimulent une réflexion entrepreneuriale des élèves; encouragent des activités culturelles, artistiques, sportives et sociales dans les écoles; et coordonnent des corps éducatifs et parents. Le CFNU soutient le réaménagement d'une bibliothèque scolaire endommagée par le tremblement de terre :

1. restauration de la bibliothèque,
2. achat de mobilier de bureau (4 tables, 40 chaises),
3. achat de livres, 4. acquisition de
- 4 PC.

Peru, Iquitos : Apostolic Vicariate of Iquitos

The Apostolic Vicariate of Iquitos develops social work for the community, focused on: access to clean water; shelter and human attention; Amazon governance with emphasis on the rights of the most vulnerable; Strengthening communication through a radio station. This project supports up to 80 adolescents and young mothers living in extreme poverty to develop entrepreneurial skills for their development and economic autonomy. They develop self-esteem, technical skills and personal security through training to carry out entrepreneurial activities.

Specifically, this project designs and implements 5 cooperative business plans that teenage mothers and young women can manage. It provides the salaries of a technical coordinator, instructors and mentors. It also purchases training books, materials and accessories, and office supplies.

Projects Supported by UNWG Geneva in 2024

South Africa, Johannesburg : SOLE Institute

This project directly benefits 70 children in grades 1 to 6, and touches 200 family beneficiaries indirectly. The SOLE (Self-Organized Learning Environments) Institute promotes education to empower South African youth. It works with the Mitra Academy, a school in Johannesburg. The Digital empowerment for underprivileged children aims to bridging literacy and numeracy with technology; the UNWG has provided 20 Chrome books.

Sierra Leone, Western Area: Education for all /Pour tous

Education for all reaches 21-25 young women per year to develop collaborative, impactful communities through educational projects that bring knowledge and the skills needed for self-sufficiency. Specific Assistance to the vocational centre in Masantigie, off Waterloo, focuses on the empowerment of young women and girls by enabling them to become self-sufficient through learning to sew their own clothing and create products to generate income. The centre helps them to find jobs in the textile industry or start their own business, it provides education and training such as sewing and pattern-making, enabling them to improve their chances of finding employment and achieving financial sustainability. By providing employment opportunities, the centre can help to reduce poverty and improve the standard of living in the community. The UNWG supported the purchase of 12 new sewing machines and sewing materials, plus payment of a teacher to teach the skills.

Sri Lanka, Matara : Matara Baudhka Kantha Samithiya (Girls orphanage)

Matara Baudhka Kantha Samithiya (Girl's orphanage) has been in operation since 1963, housing 30 girls between the ages of 5 and 18. These girls attend government schools and go on to become productive members of the society. The UNWG provided solar panels for generating sustainable electricity: 8 solar panels have now reduced the cost of electricity which sky rocketed after the economic crisis in Sri Lanka.

Projects Supported by UNWG Geneva in 2024

Sri Lanka, Piloyandala : Foundation for Peace and Love

Foundation for peace and love was funded in 2023 for building a new preschool. This required building materials, playground equipment, furniture, and water supply. The Community Development Centre, Higgoda Ashoka Preschool, Kiralagolla Galewela touches up to 50 preschool children per year.

Ukraine, Kyiv: Future for Ukraine charity foundation

The Future for GIDNA project provides free psychological assistance to women who have experienced or witnessed sexual violence during the war. It also provides supervision to the psychotherapists working with these women. Most support pays the costs of the individual supervision and 100 psychotherapy sessions.

Kenya, Nairobi : Mukuru Promotion Centre

The Mukuru Promotion Centre, located in the Mukuru slum in Nairobi, aims to improve the lives of the slum dwellers, through education, vocational training, health services and social services. This project provides mentorship for 30 mothers, income-generating activities for 10 mothers, care packages for 10 mothers, and secondary / vocational education for 10 mothers. The main goals are to improve the livelihoods of teenage mothers, through educational support and economic empowerment; to reduce the risk of repeated pregnancies through mentorship training; establishing income-generating activities; to provide care packages for newborns; and to improve literacy levels.

Dominican Republic: Hogar de Ninas Hijas de la Altigracia (Home for girls, daughters of Altigracia)

The Hogar de Ninas Hijas de la Altigracia (Home for Girls, Daughters of the Highest Grace) ensures and promotes the wellbeing of 20 to 25 orphaned girls, provides them with comprehensive education grounded in human, moral and Christian values, offering them protection and affection. The specific project, Help for Orphan Girls in the Dominican Republic, improves the academic education through appropriate equipment of the homework room. This includes 8 computers to enable the girls to do their homework and carry out training sessions. The UPS (uninterrupted power supply) units provided will help overcome power outages and protect the new equipment from damage.

Zimbabwe: ZimHealth Europe

ZimHealth Europe raises funds in Europe and distributes them to needy health facilities in Zimbabwe, with a focus on maternal and child health. Mt Selinda Hospital Maternity Clinic aims to improve maternal health and to reduce perinatal mortality rates in the 30 villages which are in the catchment area. This is done by engaging the local population and identifying critical needs in the hospital, subsequently providing adequate equipment. The current project supplies: vital signs monitors, sphygmomanometers, scales for both adult and baby, linen and surgical gowns. It reaches up to 300 women and 300 newborns.

Uzbekistan: Karkalpakstan Hospital

This project renovates and supplies a classroom for patients, a physical therapy room and a playroom at a multidisciplinary medical centre, for children 0 to 16 years of age.

Cameroun : Association des Parents d'élèves et enseignants de l'école primaire

L'Association des Parents d'élèves et enseignants de l'école primaire d'Ihouck cherche à créer des conditions favorables pour assurer la scolarisation des enfants en milieu rural. Ce projet de réhabilitation de l'école primaire du village Ihouck est en phase 2, c'est à dire la réhabilitation du deuxième bâtiment : 1. réfection de la toiture (construction de la charpente), 2. lissage des sols et murs intérieurs de 3 salles de classe, 3. bois pour 150 tables bancs et 5 tableaux, 4. matériel didactique et d'entretien (boîtes à pharmacie, papiers hygiéniques, rames de papier, bics, cahiers). Il touche 120 élèves et 5 enseignants.

Benin : "La famille"

"La famille" est un orphelinat qui aide les enfants en leur offrant un cadre de vie familial, une éducation, une formation et leur insertion socio-professionnelle. Le projet "Espoirs 50" a pour objectif de subvenir aux besoins de 50 enfants répartis en 2 groupes:

- groupe de 25 enfants qui a besoin d'une aide alimentaire de base pour leur survie ;
- groupe de 25 enfants qui a besoin d'aide matérielle pour créer un environnement stimulant. Il s'agit aussi de l'achat de denrées alimentaires non périssables pour constituer une banque alimentaire, ainsi que des meubles (bibliothèque, tables, chaises), livres, tapis puzzles, jouets.
